If you are not satisfied with this response, you may appeal to the appellate authority, the Director of Administration and Management, Office of the Secretary of Defense. Your appeal should be postmarked within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter, should cite to USSTRATCOM FOIA case number 14-015, and should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
