This letter is the final response to your January 3, 2010 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request Log # 10-038 to the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), in which you requested "the contents of the administrative processing file/folder (including emails) associated with the handling of either of the following two NIST FOIA requests: 09-11 and 09-48. By administrative processing file/folder, I mean any materials including emails concerning the processing of the request but not the underlying requested records." On January 12, 2010, we received your clarified request saying that you "are interested in the administrative processing file contents and email associated with **BOTH** prior FOIA requests 09-11 and 09-48."

Two documents consisting of two (2) pages are being released with some redactions pursuant to FOIA exemption 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(4).

Exemption (b)(4) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(4)), which exempts from disclosure "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential."

Ten (10) documents consisting of twenty-seven (27) pages are being released with some redactions pursuant to FOIA exemption 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5).

Nineteen (19) documents consisting of twenty-eight (28) pages are being withheld in their entirety pursuant to FOIA exemption 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5).

Exemption (b)(5) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(5)), permits NIST to withhold documents that are reflective of the deliberative process. Because the records are "predecisional and antecedent to the adoption of an agency policy," and "a direct part of the deliberative process in that it makes recommendations or expresses opinions on legal or policy matters," they are properly withholdable under the FOIA.

Three (3) documents consisting of seven (7) pages are being released with some redactions pursuant to FOIA exemptions 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5) and (b)(6).

Exemption (b)(6) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(6)), exempts from disclosure "personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."



Forty-two (42) documents consisting of sixty-four (64) pages are being released with some redactions pursuant to FOIA exemptions 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6).

You have the right to appeal a denial or partial denial of the FOIA request. An appeal must be received within 30 calendar days of the date of this response letter.

This letter is the final response to your February 4, 2009, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) #09–48 request to the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) in which you requested a copy of "Case B input and output from the ANSYS analysis as described on page 35 of NCSTAR 1A, The Final Report on the Collapse of the World Trade Center Building 7."

Enclosed you will find a disc that contains 8,910 files (approximately 73% of all responsive records) that can be released and are responsive to your request for Case B input and output from the ANSYS analysis. The files on the disc contain input files of a version of the 16-story ANSYS model of the World Trade Center (WTC) 7 structure, which does not include the connection models and was analyzed with service gravity loads, and Case B input temperature files.

We are, however, withholding 3,370 files (approximately 27% of all responsive records) The NIST Director determined that the release of these data might jeopardize public safety. This withheld data include remaining input and all results files of the ANSYS 16-story Case B collapse initiation model, break element source code, ANSYS script files for the break elements, custom executable ANSYS file, and all spreadsheets and other supporting calculations used to develop floor connection failure modes and capacities. In order to work with the ANSYS files, a copy of the licensed software is required.

These records are currently exempt from disclosure under section (b)(3) of the FOIA, S.C. § 552 (b)(3). Exemption (b)(3) permits an agency to withhold records in an agency's cossession which are records that are "specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than 5 U.S.C. 552(b)), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on the issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld."

The statute underlying the (b)(3) exemption in this case is the National Construction Safety Team (NCST) Act, 15 U.S.C. § 7301 et seq. Section 12 of the NCST Act (15 U.S.C. § 7311) provides that it applies to the activities of NIST in response to the attacks of September 11, 2001. Section 7(d) of the NCST Act (15 U.S.C. § 7306(d)), exempts from disclosure, information received by NIST in the course of investigations regarding building failures if the Director finds that the disclosure of the information might jeopardize public safety. On July 9, 2009, the Director of NIST determined that release of the withheld information might jeopardize public safety. Therefore, these records are being withheld.

This letter is the final response to your November 13, 2008. Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) #09–11 request to the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) in which you requested "a complete 'Certified' legitimate copy of the Computer Models used by NIST to come to the conclusions it reached in the investigation of events of September 11, 2001." On November 18, 2008 you clarified your request to include "only the model in question that was released on NIST's website in reference to World Trade Center (WTC) 7 demise."

Enclosed you will find a disc that contains 19,114 files (approximately 20% of all responsive records) that can be released and are responsive to your request for the Computer Models used by NIST. The files on the disc contain input files of a version of the 16-story ANSYS model of the WTC 7 structure that does not include the connection models and was analyzed with service gravity loads, 3 sets of ANSYS input temperature files, and input files of the 47-story LS-DYNA global collapse model of the WTC 7 structure with no connection details.

We are, however, withholding 74,777 files (approximately 80% of all responsive records). The NIST Director determined that the release of these data might jeopardize public safety. This withheld data include remaining input and all results files of the ANSYS 16-story collapse initiation model, break element source code. ANSYS script files for the break elements, custom executable ANSYS file, all input and results files of the LS-DYNA 47-story global collapse model, and all spreadshoets and other supporting calculations used to develop floor connection failure modes and capacities. In order to work with the ANSYS and LS-DYNA files, a copy of the licensed software is required.

These records are currently exempt from disclosure under section (b)(3) of the FOiA. 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3). Exemption (b)(3) permits an agency to withhold records in an agency's possession which are records that are "specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than 15 U.S.C. 552(b)), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on the issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld."



The statute underlying the (b)(3) exemption in this case is the National Construction Safety Team (NCST) Act, 15 U.S.C. § 7301 et seq. Section 12 of the NCST Act (15 U.S.C. § 7311) provides that it applies to the activities of NIST in response to the attacks of September 11, 2001. Section 7(d) of the NCST Act (15 U.S.C. § 7306(d)), exempts from disclosure, information received by NIST in the course of the investigations regarding building failures if the Director finds that the disclosure of the information might jeopardize public safety. On July 9, 2009, the Director of NIST determined that release of the withheld information might jeopardize public safety. Therefore, these records are being withheld.
