Please note that we have redacted the enclosed documents pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA, which exempts federal agencies from disclosing files that would constitute a “clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). Specifically, we have redacted FOIA requestors’ personal contact information, and we have also redacted the names of individuals who submitted Privacy Act requests or FOIA requests for records about themselves, because such requestors ordinarily have an expectation of privacy in the fact that they submitted their request.

The U.S. Commission on Civil Rights is an independent fact-finding agency authorized by Congress to investigate a broad range of civil rights issues, including investigating voting rights complaints, studying and collecting information related to discrimination or denial of equal protection of the law on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, disability or national origin, and appraising federal laws and policies with respect to these issues.

If you consider my response to be a denial of your request you may appeal within 90 days of this letter by filing a written request for review addressed to the Staff Director of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, 624 Ninth Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20425, by certified mail, including a copy of the written denial. You may include a statement of the circumstances, reasons or arguments advanced in support of disclosure. *See* 45 C.F.R. § 704.1(g). Both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked “Freedom of Information Act Appeal.”

The Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") is one of the most important tools for government transparency and accountability. In their mission to find waste, fraud, and abuse, the oversight and investigative committees of Congress, including the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform ("Committee"), are often assisted by tips, complaints, and briefings from media organizations, watchdog groups, and concerned citizens. These private-sector actors are often the first to become aware of federal inefficiency or malfeasance. FOIA allows them to scrutinize the activities of federal agencies. Without FOIA, they could not hold the government accountable, nor could they provide crucial assistance to Congressional oversight. President Obama recognized the importance of FOIA when he made it the subject of an executive memorandum on his second day in office.¹

The Committee, as the principal oversight committee in the House of Representatives with broad oversight jurisdiction as set forth in House Rule X, is very interested in ensuring that all federal agencies respond in a timely, substantive, and non-discriminatory manner to requests for information under FOIA. To enable the Committee to understand the impact of recent changes to FOIA procedures and to evaluate agencies' compliance with FOIA, please provide the following information, records, and explanations by **February 15, 2011 at 5:00 pm**.

1. Provide your agency's FOIA log(s) for the five years preceding the date of this letter, in Microsoft Excel or a similar format that allows sorting by column or information category, including at least the following information: (a) the name of the requestor; (b) the date of the request; (c) a brief description of the documents or records sought by the request; (d) any tracking number assigned to the request by your agency pursuant to

Section 7 of the OPEN Government Act of 2007²; (e) the date the request was closed, if it is not still outstanding; (f) whether any records were provided in response to the request; and (g) any additional identification number or code assigned to the request by your agency for internal use.



Definition of Terms

1. The term "record" means any written, recorded, or graphic matter of any nature whatsoever, regardless of how recorded, and whether original or copy, including, but not limited to, the following: memoranda, reports, expense reports, books, manuals, instructions, financial reports, working papers, records notes, letters, notices, confirmations, telegrams, receipts, appraisals, pamphlets, magazines, newspapers, prospectuses, interoffice and intra office communications, electronic mail (e-mail), contracts, cables, notations of any type of conversation, telephone call, meeting or other communication, bulletins, printed matter, computer printouts, teletypes, invoices, transcripts, diaries, analyses, returns, summaries, minutes, bills, accounts, estimates, projections, comparisons, messages, correspondence, press releases, circulars, financial statements, reviews, opinions, offers, studies and investigations, questionnaires and surveys, and work sheets (and all drafts, preliminary versions, alterations, modifications, revisions, changes, and amendments of any of the foregoing, as well as any attachments or appendices thereto), and graphic or oral records or representations of any kind (including without limitation, photographs, charts, graphs, microfiche, microfilm, videotape, recordings and motion pictures), and electronic, mechanical, and electric records or representations of any kind (including, without limitation, tapes, cassettes, disks, and recordings) and other written, printed, typed, or other graphic or recorded matter of any kind or nature, however produced or reproduced, and whether preserved in writing, film, tape, disk, videotape or otherwise. A record bearing any notation not a part of the original text is to be considered a separate record. A draft or non-identical copy is a separate record within the meaning of this term.
2. The term "communication" means each manner or means of disclosure or exchange of information, regardless of means utilized, whether oral, electronic, by document or otherwise, and whether face-to-face, in a meeting, by telephone, mail, telexes, discussions, releases, personal delivery, or otherwise.
3. The terms "referring or relating," with respect to any given subject, means anything that constitutes, contains, embodies, reflects, identifies, states, refers to, deals with or is in any manner whatsoever pertinent to that subject.

Enclosed please find the response of the United States Commission on Civil Rights ("Commission") to your Request for Information concerning Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") requests received by the Commission.

As you review our response, please note that the Commission is a small federal agency – it has approximately thirty employees and only receives a few dozen FOIA requests per year. Due to its limited resources and low volume of requests, the Commission historically has had one employee tasked with processing its FOIA requests, and he/she spends a small portion of his/her time doing so. The Commission's only FOIA officer retired at the end of June 2010, and the Commission did not hire and train a replacement until October 2010 – a lag which resulted in a backlog between FY 2010 and FY 2011 and which is reflected in our enclosed response.

Please also be aware that in October 2010 the Commission instituted several changes to its FOIA response system in order to make it more organized, more efficient and more effective. For example, the Commission began assigning FOIA tracking numbers to each FOIA request it receives, as required by 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(7)(A). The Commission also began tracking its FOIA requests electronically, and it adopted a new internal filing system for its requests. All of these changes were made with an eye toward reducing unnecessary delays in FOIA processing.

Because these mechanisms were not in place before October 2010, much of the information that you seek was not consistently tracked prior to that date. As a result, we have reviewed our agency files and constructed new FOIA logs that comply with your request.

Please find narrative responses to your requests below:

Request No. 1:

Provide your agency's FOIA log(s) for the five years preceding the date of this letter, in Microsoft Excel or a similar format that allows sorting by column or information category, including at least the following information: (1) the name of the requestor; (b) the date of the request; (c) a brief description of the documents or records sought by the request; (d) any tracking number assigned to the request by your agency pursuant to Section 7 of the OPEN Government Act of 2007; (e) the date the request was closed, if it is not still outstanding; (f) whether any records were provided in response to the request, and (g) any additional identification number or code assigned to the request by your agency for internal use.

Response:

Please see the enclosed Microsoft Excel spreadsheet. FOIA requests are logged by fiscal year, with each worksheet representing a different fiscal year. Where a FOIA request was received in one fiscal year and closed in another fiscal year, it is logged in both worksheets and so noted. Please also note that the tracking numbers requested in (d) have not been assigned to FOIA requests processed in or before FY 2009. As discussed above, the Commission did not begin assigning tracking numbers to FOIA requests until October 2010; FOIA requests from FY 2010 were assigned tracking numbers retroactively in order to compile the Commission's FY 2010 Annual FOIA Report, which was submitted to the U.S. Department of Justice in December. In addition, please note that the Commission does not assign any additional identification numbers or codes, as requested in (g).

Request No. 2:

On each log provided in response to Request No. 1, identify each FOIA request to your agency that was submitted more than 45 days prior to the date of this letter and to which your agency has not yet issued a complete and final response.

Response:

While reviewing its records to respond to this information request, Commission staff located two FOIA requests – one each from FY 2008 and FY 2009 – that do not appear to have been closed out. These requests are noted in the enclosed FOIA logs. Please be assured that the Commission is now working expeditiously to close these requests.

Request No. 3:

For each FOIA request identified in response to Request No. 2, provide all communications between your agency and the requestor.

Enclosed please find the FOIA requests identified in response to Request No. 2. As of this writing, there have been no additional communications between the Commission and the requestors with respect these FOIA requests. To protect the requestors' privacy, their personal contact information has been redacted.


