This letter responds to your December 17, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE). You requested a copy of the meeting minutes from the Legislation Committee and the Investigations Committee for calendar years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.

We are releasing 77 pages of responsive documents. Pursuant to FOIA, certain information has been redacted as it is exempt from release. Specifically, in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), the names of individuals were withheld because release of this information could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Content pertaining to deliberative processes was withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5).

A total of 56 pages have been withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5). Four pages of duplicates were withheld.

We have enclosed a brief explanation of the FOIA exemptions.

You have the right to appeal CIGIE's response by writing to the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, 1717 H Street NW., Suite 825, Washington, D.C. 20006-3900. Your appeal must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. The outside of the envelope should be clearly marked "FOIA APPEAL."

# **FOIA EXEMPTIONS**

<u>Exemption 2</u> (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(2)): permits agencies to withhold documents which relate "solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency."

<u>Exemption 3</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3)): incorporates the disclosure prohibitions that are contained in various other federal statutes. Broadly phrased so as to simply cover information "specifically exempted from disclosure by statute."

<u>Exemption 4</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4)): allows Federal agencies the discretion to withhold "... trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person [that is] privileged or confidential..." the release of which could be competitively harmful to the submitter of the information; which could impair the government's ability to obtain similar necessary information in a purely voluntary manner in the future; and, which could affect other governmental interests, such as program effectiveness and compliance.

<u>Exemption 5</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5)): allows the agency the discretion to withhold "...inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency." The purpose of this exemption is to protect the deliberative process by encouraging a frank exchange of views. In addition, this exemption protects from disclosure attorneywork product and attorney-client materials.

<u>Exemption 6</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6)): allows Federal agencies the discretion to withhold information the disclosure of which would "...constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion..." of individual privacy and might adversely affect the individual and his/her family.

<u>Exemption 7</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)): protects from disclosure "records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information

- (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings,
- (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication,
- (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,

(D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of a record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or

(E) would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or

(F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual."

<u>Exemption 8</u> (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(8)): protects matters that are "contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions."

Exemption 9 (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(9)): covers geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

# **PRIVACY ACT EXEMPTIONS**


Exemption (b) (5 U.S.C. § 552a(b)): applies to information concerning other individuals which may not be released without their consent.


Exemption (d)(5) (5 U.S.C. § 552a(d)(5)): protects information compiled in reasonable anticipation of a civil action or proceeding.

Exemption (j)(2) (5 U.S.C. § 552a(j)(2)): permits law enforcement agencies to withhold information compiled for the purpose of a criminal investigation, including reports of informants and investigators, which are associated with an identifiable individual.

Exemption (k)(2) (5 U.S.C. § 552a(k)(2)): permits agencies to withhold investigatory material compiled for law enforcement purposes, other than material within the scope of Exemption (j)(2).

Exemption (k)(5) (5 U.S.C. § 552a(k)(5)): applies to investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment, or access to classified information, release of which would disclose a confidential source.

On appeal, Inspector General Phyllis Fong, CIGIE Chair, remanded 25 pages of your request to FOIA staff for further processing to release additional content. FOIA staff received the remanded request on September 7, 2012, and assigned it FOIA Log No. 6330-2013-5.

We have enclosed 25 pages of responsive records. Pursuant to FOIA, certain information has been redacted as it is exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552. Content pertaining to deliberative processes was withheld under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5). In accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), the names, signatures, initials, and other identifying information of individuals were withheld because release of this information could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have enclosed a brief explanation of FOIA exemptions.

You have the right to appeal CIGIE's response by writing to the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, 1717 H Street NW., Suite 825, Washington, D.C. 20006-3900. Your appeal must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. The outside of the envelope should be clearly marked "FOIA APPEAL."

**C** ble **D** referred attendees to a September 1 letter from the Committee to HSGAC regarding a proposed amendment to S. 372, the Whistleblower Protection Enhancement Act. It echoes concerns the Committee expressed in a previous letter to HSGAC regarding section 120(a) of the bill, which would require IGs to designate a "Whistleblower Protection Ombudsman" to educate, advise and advocate for agency employees who make protected disclosures. The amendment would remove the advocacy role from section 120(a) but retain the education and advisory roles. It would also change the term used in the IG Act to refer to the selection of AIGs from "appoint" to "designate". The letter reiterates CIGIE's position that requiring IGs to supervise someone acting as an advisor to agency employees with potential claims against the Agency could conflict with their mandate under the IG Act to operate independently and objectively. The letter also expresses concern that the change in terms could unnecessarily confuse an IG's current power to "appoint"AIGs with the proposed power to "designate"an Ombudsman to the extent that "designate" implies selecting a current OIG employee to assume additional responsibilities. The letter further recommends the Ombudsmen be placed outside of OIGs as the role is programmatic and thus more appropriate for agency management.
