This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request seeking the weekly or monthly FOIA program internal status report for U.S. Central Command (USCENTCOM) during calendar years 2015 and 2016.

USCENTCOM conducted a thorough good faith search and located 46 pages. After a thorough review, I have determined that portions of the documents are exempt from release. The withheld information is exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), personal privacy interests.

Accordingly, in my capacity as the Initial Denial Authority for FOIA, by withholding this information, I am partially denying the information released under FOIA. No allowable fees could be charged for this request pursuant to DoDM 5400.07. For any further assistance and to discuss any aspect of your request, you have the right to contact the Office of the Deputy Chief Management Officer, Directorate for Oversight and Compliance, The Transparency Office, FOIA Public Liaison (Mr. James Hogan) at OSD.FOIA-APPEAL@mail.mil. 




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




FOIA Productivity Status December 2014




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months






FOIA Productivity Status February 2015




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months








Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months








Monthly Trends Past 12 Months








Monthly Trends Past 12 Months




Monthly Trends Past 12 Months
