The U.S. Office of Government Ethics (OGE) is granting in part and denying in part your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, which was received by the OGE FOIA Office on October 31, 2016. In your request, you asked for a "copy of the Freedom of Information Act APPEALS Log for the Office of Government Ethics for the time period since 2006."

OGE does not maintain separate FOIA appeals logs. Instead, we track appeals information in our FOIA logs.
