Officers were questioned that worked the weekend no one recalled any incidents with the painting and thought the indentation was preexisting. Exhibition staff Amber Kerr verified that the damage was new. Watch Commander Fernando Diaz, Jr. was notified. The camera associated with the location of the painting is # 2018 and looking at the camera you cannot see the indentation. The camera will be reviewed further to see if it can be determined when the damage occurred.
