Certain information has been withheld from these records pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(C), which protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The information withheld consists of the names of special agents, individuals, third-party individuals and titles. We redacted the remaining information as unresponsive to your request. If you desire any of the information redacted as nonresponsive, you should submit a new FOIA request explaining what information you are seeking.
