On June 18, 2018, the Bureau of Engraving and Printing (BEP), FOIA and Transparency Services received your request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. §552, for the following:

I request a copy of the Spoilage Report and Spoilage Trend Analysis for Currency Production. I limit this request to each of the two Monthly reports described above, during the years 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018 to date.

For tracking purposes, the request was FOIA Request Number 2018-06-102.

On July 12, 2018, the Agency's Fee Letter was sent to you, via electronic mail, notifying you of the estimated costs associated with your request. In response to the fee letter, you notified the Agency that you thought there was an error in the fee amount as it appeared to charge for review. I contacted you on July 12, 2018, regarding your concern and informed you that an error was made and offered to amend the fee agreement. You stated that you would narrow the scope of the request to lessen the financial burden. In addition, options were discussed on how you could narrow the request included reducing the number of years request, type of document requested and/or the facility to the documents applied. In a July 12, 2018, email you narrowed your request to the following:

"I hereby narrow my request assigned case number 2018-06-201 in order to reduce the administrative burden. I limit my request to the Spoilage Report and Spoilage Trend Analysis for Currency Production for the Washington, DC

location only for each month in 2018 to date only." Your request further noted that you "agree to pay up to \$35 for costs if necessary."

A search for records was conducted and documents responsive to your request are enclosed. No fees will be charged for processing your request. However, please note that when it is believed that a requester or group of requesters is attempting to break a request down into a series of requests for the purpose of evading the assessment of fees, the Bureau may aggregate these requests and charge accordingly. Thus, any future requests of the documents contained in your original request may be aggregated as it pertains to fees.
