This responds to your February 28, 2020, request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, for a listing of Inspector General investigations closed during calendar years 2018 and 2019.

I have attached the requested records, which comprise 3 pages and include redactions of the identifying information of lower-level subjects of investigations, and also the identifying information of two higher-level subjects where the investigations did not sustain the allegations of wrongdoing. The identities of these investigative subjects are protected under (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of FOIA, which protect personal privacy interests.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2006 & Supp. IV 2010). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

If you are not satisfied with my action on this request, you may file an administrative appeal in writing within 90 days of the date of this letter.
