This is the Department of Treasury's (Treasury) final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated February 17, 2017. You sought various records pertaining to "Treasury INTRAnet home page. Second, a copy of the main pages associated with these sections of the Treasury INTRAnet: What's New, Councils/Working Groups, Ethics/Legal, For Managers, Forms/Directives/Policy, Records/Information Mgt, Reports/Publications, Strategic Planning/Budget, and Treasury Web Sites. Third, a copy of listing of Reports and Publications from the Treasury INTRAnet."

Your request has been processed under the provisions of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552. Of the 16 pages reviewed, sections of 13 pages will be withheld pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA as described below. After carefully considering these records, I am releasing a total of 3 pages in their entirety.

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

Since Treasury's partial denial response constitutes an adverse action, you have the right to appeal this determination within 90 days from the date of this letter. By filing an appeal, you preserve your rights under FOIA and give the agency a chance to review and reconsider your request and the agency's decision. Your appeal must be in writing, be signed by you or your representative, contain the rationale for your appeal, and cite the FOIA reference number noted above. Please address your appeal to:

Washington, D.C. 20220 If you submit your appeal by mail, clearly mark the letter and the envelope with the words "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
