This letter is our final response regarding your Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (CDC/ATSDR) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of May 26, 2019, assigned #19-00854-FOIA, seeking:

a copy of each email containing the word LUBER from an electronic search of the emails of the Division of Environmental Hazards and Health Effects during the time period January 1, 2018 to the present. I limit this request to the Director and the Deputy Director of the Division and the Chief, Air Pollution and Respiratory Health Branch.

We received your narrowed scope dated July 1, 2019, which you narrowed your scope to the following information:

a copy of each email containing the word LUBER from an electronic search of the emails of the Division of Environmental Hazards and Health Effects during the time period January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

I limit this request to the Director and the Deputy Director of the Division and the Chief, Air Pollution and Respiratory Health Branch. Please exclude all news clips and news articles. Please omit any emails in which Luber was a recipient. Please omit any emails in which Luber was copied. Please omit any emails in which Luber appears in a signature block.

I trust that this good faith narrowing of my request will significantly reduce the number of potentially responsive records. Please note that this request is limited to only the emails in the accounts of three people at CDC.

We also received your revised narrowed scope on July 2, 2020, which you revised the narrow scope to the following information:

a copy of each email containing the word LUBER from an electronic search of the emails of each of the following individuals during the time period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018:

Michael McGeehin, Ph.D.	Mike Donnelly
Dr. Erik R. Svendsen	Laurie A. Johnson, MPH
Josephine Malilay, Ph.D.	Dr. Patrick Braysse

Please exclude all news clips and news articles. Please omit any emails in which Luber was a recipient or sender. Please omit any emails in which Luber was copied. Please omit any emails in which Luber appears in a signature block.

We located 427 pages of responsive records (59 pages released in full; 45 pages released in part; 323 pages withheld in full). After a careful review of these pages, some information was withheld from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. §552 Exemptions 5 and 6.


Exemption 5 protects inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency. Exemption 5 therefore incorporates the privileges that protect materials from discovery in litigation, including the deliberative process, attorney work-product, and attorney-client privileges. Information withheld under this exemption was protected under the deliberative process and attorney-client privileges. The deliberative process privilege protects the decision-making process of government agencies. The deliberative process privilege protects materials that are both predecisional and deliberative. The materials that have been withheld under the deliberative process privilege of Exemption 5 are both predecisional and deliberative, and do not contain or represent formal or informal agency policies or decisions. Examples of information withheld include deliberative discussions regarding cell phone verification and George Luber's detail. The attorney-client privilege protects "confidential communications between an attorney and his client relating to a legal matter for which the client has sought professional advice" and is not limited to the context of litigation. The information that has been withheld under the attorney-client privilege of Exemption 5 constitutes confidential communications between agency attorneys and agency clients.

Exemption 6 protects information in personnel and medical files and similar files when disclosure would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The information that has been withheld under Exemption 6 consists of personal information, such as personal cell phone numbers contained in an invoice for a government issued cell phone. We have determined that the individuals to whom this information pertains has a substantial privacy interest in withholding it.

I am a reporter with E&E News, an online news outlet that covers environmental and energy issues.

As you may be aware, Public Employees for Environmental Responsibility has released a narrative ([https://www.peer.org/assets/docs/cdc/12\\_20\\_18\\_Luber\\_Whistleblower\\_Narrative.pdf](https://www.peer.org/assets/docs/cdc/12_20_18_Luber_Whistleblower_Narrative.pdf)) alleging that you were involved in efforts to retaliate against Dr. Luber. I've reached out to the CDC press office, but have so far gotten no response. I'm aware that there are often multiple sides to a story, so just wanted to check with you on a couple of points:

1. The narrative says that you and Pam Protzel Berman ordered Dr. Luber to cancel a planned climate change event scheduled for February 2017 that was to feature former Vice President Gore. Is that accurate and, if so, what was the reason for that decision? If not, how is it inaccurate?
2. The PEER account says you instructed Dr. Luber "that for any future meetings or public statements he should not use the words 'climate change,' and should instead use language like 'extreme weather.'" Is that accurate and, if so, why did you offer those instructions? If not, how is it inaccurate?
3. The PEER narrative suggests that you played a role in the alleged campaign to retaliate against Dr. Luber, both by advancing the consolidation/reorganization at the National Center for Environmental Health and by seeking his removal. Do you have any comment?
