

Services of Common Concern

REFERENCE: (U) National Collection Committees, E/S 01278, 30 Nov 2007

(U//~~FOUO~~) Consistent with the decision to retain the National Collection Committees (reference) and the existence of the Measurement and Signature Intelligence (MASINT) Community Executive as the Intelligence Community (IC) Intelligence Discipline Manager, we are assigning responsibilities and corresponding resources for managing and executing the MASINT services of common concern (SoCC) to the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA). The Deputy Director of National Intelligence for Collection will work with the Chief Financial Officer and your staff to ensure that personnel and funding for the MASINT SoCC are appropriately identified in the budget structure and the Congressional Budget Justification Books.

(U//~~FOUO~~) To accomplish these responsibilities effectively on behalf of the IC, MASINT SoCC related to the MASINT Requirements System and Data Broker, MASINT Portal, MASINT Data and Products Standards, MASINT Architectures, MASINT Training and Education, MASINT Research and Development, MASINT Policy, and the National Consortium for MASINT Research will be assigned to DIA. The continued effective performance of the MASINT SoCC is essential and we request your assistance to ensure continuity of operations, and as necessary, work with the MASINT Community Executive to draft an execution plan within 60 days.

(U) Our intent is to ensure the experience level of MASINT personnel currently performing these functions is preserved. DIA will continue to administratively handle all personnel-related actions-- including pay, bonuses, and performance reports---for DIA employees filling General Defense Intelligence Program billets. Your assistance in this endeavor will result in an improved management structure for the MASINT Community. Your leadership will be vital as we work to elevate the stature of MASINT and as we reach out to other program managers, customers, and senior community leadership.
