This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of 6 August 2000 for "A copy of the NSA HQ FOIA Case Log for October 1, 1998 to the present." Per your written annotation on the bottom of page two of our letter of 29 September 2000, you stated that you agreed to narrow your request to the subject, date received, and requester's name, with the omission of first party or Privacy Act requests and referrals, and you requested that logs should cover through 6 October 2000. Enclosed are copies of your request and NSA's 29 September 2000 letter containing your annotation regarding the narrowing of your request. On 10 September 2004 in a telephone conversation with Pamela Phillips, Chief of the FOIA/PA Office, you agreed that if we were unable to recreate a log as it appeared on the date of your original request, you would accept a current pull of what was on the HO. During that conversation you also agreed to allow us to omit origination dates; however, we were subsequently able to reformat the reports and generate a log containing those dates. There are no assessable fees for this request. Your request has been processed under the FOIA, and the HQ log generated on 1 October 2004 is enclosed. Certain information, however, has been deleted from the enclosures.

This Agency is authorized by statute to protect certain information concerning its activities, as well as the names of its employees. Such information is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the third exemption of the FOIA which provides for the withholding of information specifically protected from disclosure by statute. The specific statute applicable in this case is Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 402 <u>note</u>). We have determined that such information exists in this record, and we have excised it accordingly.

In addition, information regarding other individuals has been deleted from the enclosures in accordance with 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(6). This exemption protects from disclosure information which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. In balancing the public interest for the information you request against the privacy interests involved, we have determined that the privacy interests sufficiently satisfy the requirements for the application of the (b)(6) exemption.

Since these deletions may be construed as a partial denial of your request, you are hereby advised of this Agency's appeal procedures. Any person denied access to information may file an appeal to the NSA/CSS Freedom of Information Act Appeal Authority. The appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days from the date of the initial denial letter. The appeal shall be in writing addressed to the NSA/CSS FOIA Appeal Authority (DC34), National Security Agency, 9800 Savage Road STE 6248, Fort George G. Meade, MD 20755-6248. The appeal shall reference the initial denial of access and shall contain, in sufficient detail and particularity, the grounds upon which the requester believes release of the information is required. The NSA/CSS Appeal Authority will endeavor to respond to the appeal within 20 working days after receipt, absent any unusual circumstances.
