This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated and received on February 26, 2021, via the National FOIA Portal, seeking access to records maintained by the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA). Specifically, you requested:

A copy of each email in the TIGTAcommunications email box (TIGTAcommunications@tigta.treas.gov) that has the subject line as "Notification of FOIA Request from Media". I limit this request to a search emails in that email box limited to the timeframe May 1, 2019 to the present. If for some reason this email account is not searchable, then I instead request the same search from the account of Amy Jones.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

Per your request, we asked that TIGTA's Office of Information Technology conduct a search of the TIGTA Communications email box (TIGTACommunications @tigta.treas.gov) for emails with the subject line "Notification of FOIA Request from Media" received between May 1, 2019 and March 1, 2021, the day we commenced our records search. The search located 30 pages responsive to your request. We are releasing 10 pages in full and 20 pages in part. A copy is enclosed. We are asserting FOIA subsections (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) as the justification for withholding.

FOIA subsection (b)(6) permits the withholding of records and information about individuals when disclosure of the information could result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The withheld information consists of identifying information compiled with regard to individuals other than you. Releasing the withheld information would not shed any light into the Agency's performance of its official

functions, but instead could result in an invasion into the personal privacy of the individuals whose names and personal information have been withheld. As a result, the privacy interests of the third parties outweigh the public's interest in having the information released.

FOIA subsection (b)(7)(C) permits an agency to withhold "information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The withheld information consists of identifying information of individuals other than you. Releasing the withheld information would not shed any light into the Agency's performance of its official functions, but instead could result in an invasion into the personal privacy of the individuals whose names and personal information have been withheld. The information was compiled for law enforcement purposes and the privacy interests of the third parties outweigh the public's interest in having the information released. As a result, this information has been withheld in response to your request.

The cost incurred to process your FOIA request was less than \$25.00, the threshold set by Treasury's FOIA regulation, so no fees were assessed.

Judicial Watch, Inc. ("Judicial Watch") hereby requests that the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration produce the following records pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 ("FOIA"), and the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a:

Any and all records regarding, concerning, or related to the disclosure of confidential tax information of President Donald Trump, the Trump Organization, and/or any related business entities. For purposes of clarification, this information was published by the New York Times on September 27, 2020. This request includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Any and all related records of communication between any official, employee, or representative of the Office of the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration and any other individual or entity, and

Any and all related tips or other information provided to the Office of the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration by any individual or entity.

Please determine whether to comply with this request within the time period required by FOIA and notify us immediately of your determination, the reasons therefor, and the right to appeal any adverse determination to the head of the agency or his or her designee. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(i). Please also produce all responsive records in an electronic format ("pdf" is preferred), if convenient. We also are willing to accept a "rolling production" of responsive records if it will facilitate a more timely production.

Judicial Watch also hereby requests a waiver of both search and duplication fees. We are entitled to a waiver of search fees because we are a "representative of the news media." See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II); see also Cause of Action v. Federal Trade Comm., 799 F.3d 1108 (D.C. Cir. 2015); Nat'l Sec. Archive v. U.S. Dep't of Defense, 880 F.2d 1381 (D.C. Cir. 1989). For more than twenty years, Judicial Watch has used FOIA and other investigative tools to gather information about the operations and activities of government, a subject of undisputed public interest. We submit over 400 FOIA requests annually. Our personnel, which includes experienced journalists and professional writers on staff and under contract, use their editorial skills to turn this raw information into distinct works that are disseminated to the public via our monthly newsletter, which has a circulation of over 300,000, weekly email update, which has over 600,000 subscribers, investigative bulletins, special reports, www.judicialwatch.org website, Corruption Chronicles blog, and social media, including Facebook and Twitter, among other distribution channels. We have authored several books, including Corruption Chronicles by Tom Fitton (Threshold Editions, July 24, 2012), and Clean House by Tom Fitton (Threshold Editions, Aug. 30, 2016). In 2012, we produced a documentary film. "District of Corruption," directed by Stephen K. Bannon. Our "news media" status has been confirmed in court rulings. See, e.g., Judicial Watch, Inc. v. U.S. Dep't of Defense, 2006 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 44003, *1 (D.D.C. June 28, 2006); Judicial Watch, Inc. v. U.S. Dep't of Justice, 133 F. Supp.2d 52 (D.D.C. 2000). As a tax exempt, 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, we have no commercial interests and do not seek the requested records for any commercial use. Rather, we intend to use the requested records as part of our ongoing investigative journalism and public education efforts to promote integrity, transparency, and accountability in government and fidelity to the rule of law.

Judicial Watch also is entitled to a waiver of both search fees and duplication fees because "disclosure of the information is in the public interest." 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii). Disclosure of the requested records undoubtedly will shed light on "the operations or activities of the government." Cause of Action, 799 F.3d at 1115 (quoting 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii)). Disclosure also is "likely to contribute significantly to the public understanding" of those operations or activities because, among other reasons, Judicial Watch intends to disseminate both the records and its findings to "a reasonably broad audience of persons interested in the subject" via its newsletter, email updates, investigative bulletins, website, blog, and its other, regular distribution channels. Cause of Action, 799 F.3d at 1116 (quoting Carney v. U.S. Dep't of Justice, 19 F.3d 807, 815 (2d Cir. 1994)). Again, Judicial Watch does not seek the requested records for any commercial benefit or for its own "primary" benefit, but instead seeks them as part of its ongoing investigative journalism and public education efforts to promote integrity, transparency, and accountability in government and fidelity to the rule of law.

In the event our request for a waiver of search and/or duplication costs is denied, Judicial Watch agrees to pay up to \$300.00 in search and/or duplication costs. Judicial Watch requests that it be contacted before any such costs are incurred, in order to
