

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

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

AGREEMENT FOR LICENSING OF SURPLUS "RAW FOOTAGE" VIDEOTAPES

This Agreement is made and entered into this <u>2372</u> day of <u>December</u>, 19<u>76</u>, by and between the County of Los Angeles, a body corporate and politic organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and FILM BANK, hereinafter referred to as "LICENSOR".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles and the Sheriff of the County of Los Angeles are charged with the duties of providing law enforcement services to a population in excess of nine million persons; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of said duties the COUNTY through its Sheriff's Department, from time-to-time produces motion picture films and videotapes for the purpose of training law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY contemplates offering the "raw footage" from these films and videotapes it produced through its Sheriff's Department for licensing solely through LICENSOR to a third party,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties hereto, it is agreed as follows:

1. <u>Term of Agreement</u>

The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of three years, renewable, in writing, by mutual consent of the parties, for an additional two year period.

2. COUNTY Agrees

Except as provided herein, LICENSOR shall be the sole and exclusive LICENSOR of "raw footage" videotapes produced by COUNTY through its Sheriff's Department. The Sheriff's Department may distribute completed productions containing "raw footage" to their own department, other law enforcement agencies, the general public and to anyone else they desire. [Specific training tapes are distributed through a Distributor of law enforcement training tapes and are not affected by this agreement.] COUNTY reserves the right to use any "raw footage" in Sheriff's Department programs, P.O.S.T. (Peace Officers Standards and Training) programs, by other Law Enforcement Agencies producing their own training videotapes and by television stations and cable companies when used in conjunction with an interview of the Sheriff or any other departmental member. The LICENSOR shall not have access to footage which reveals tactics or provides information that would place an officer in jeopardy. The LICENSOR shall not allow "raw footage" to be used in a manner where it appears that the Sheriff's Department endorses a product or service. "Raw footage" from films and videotapes will not be used in a program that depicts law enforcement in a negative way. If a third party, through the LICENSOR, wishes to use "raw footage" from the Sheriff's Department in a program that is not approved by the Sheriff's Department's guidelines and restrictions, prior approval must be obtained from the Sheriff. The COUNTY warrants that all "raw footage" provided to the LICENSOR has been shot by the Sheriff's Department unless otherwise noted.

3. LICENSOR Services

LICENSOR agrees to:

a. Duplicate tapes. LICENSOR shall incur all costs of videotape duplication and pay directly to the film processor the taboratory duplication cost for each master print of "raw

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footage" authorized by COUNTY and ordered by LICENSOR.

 LICENSOR shall be liable for all costs of distribution, Including expenses incurred in the preparation and dissemination of all promotional materials.

4. <u>Computation of Royalty to be Paid COUNTY</u>

a. For each second of "raw footage" sold by LICENSOR,
 LICENSOR shall pay COUNTY a royalty of 50 percent of
 the license fees for exclusive representation.

5. Payments

Quarterly payments to COUNTY for each calendar quarter shall be accompanied by a detailed statement showing all transactions for the preceding quarter and listing each segment of "raw footage" sold. LICENSOR shall pay amounts due to COUNTY within 45 days following the calendar quarter during which payments for the sales referred to therein were received. In the event that payment is not made or before the date herein provided, LICENSOR shall pay to COUNTY a sum of money equal to two percent per quarter of the unpaid balance due, to be included with each calendar quarterly payment when made.

All royalties may be delivered to the COUNTY on a quarterly basis or at the option of the COUNTY, held in an account by the LICENSOR and accumulated for the purpose of purchasing video equipment for the Sheriff's Advanced Training Bureau's Media Resources Section. All royalties, whether held in account or delivered to the COUNTY on a quarterly basis, shall be used by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Advanced Training Bureau's Media Resources Section, for the purchase and maintenance of video equipment.

Except as provided herein, the LICENSOR shall be the sole and exclusive LICENSOR of "raw footage" videotapes produced by the County through its Sheriff's Department.

6. Copyright Infringement

LICENSOR shall comply with the provisions of the Copyright Convention and laws of the United States of America to protect and copyright in the Material, and shall not do or neglect to do any act or thing which will or might dedicate the copyright in the Material to public domain.

7. Third Party Responsibilities

The third party who is licensed to use Sheriff's Department "raw footage" is responsible for obtaining releases or obscuring faces of identifiable people in the footage.

8. <u>Notices</u>

Notices and payments shall be sent to the COUNTY as follows:

Colima Road, Suite L-6 Whittier, California 90604 Notices and correspondence shall be sent to the LICENSOR, addressed to his place of business, or such other place as may be hereafter designated in writing by LICENSOR.

In the event of suspension or termination of the contract, notices may also be given upon personal delivery to any person which action or knowledge of such suspension or termination would be sufficient notice to the LICENSOR. Actual knowledge of such suspension or termination by an individual LICENSOR or by a copartner, vice president, secretary or general manager, if the LICENSOR be a corporation, or by the managing agent regularly in charge of the work on behalf of said LICENSOR, shall in any case be sufficient notice.

9. Maintenance of Records

LICENSOR shall maintain or cause to be maintained records and accounts in such form, format and content, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, to assure a proper accounting for all revenue generated under this Agreement. The records shall be made available for examination by COUNTY during normal business hours and shall be retained at a location in Los Angeles County during the term of this Agreement and for 12 months thereafter.

If such records and accounts are not made available to COUNTY upon reasonable request or if records and accounts are not kept within COUNTY'S physical boundaries, all travel and related expenses for records examinations and audits shall be paid by LICENSOR subject to mutual agreement prior to incurrence.

Any violation of this Contract, at the sole option and election of the COUNTY, render any Agreement void and of no force and effect, except that the LICENSOR shall remain liable for all sums due to the COUNTY and shall be obligated to forfeit to the COUNTY all master prints of "raw footage" then or thereafter in its possession. Unless otherwise agreed upon by all parties in writing, upon expiration or termination of the LICENSOR'S right hereunder, the LICENSOR agrees to deliver possession of all Master prints to the COUNTY at a cost not to exceed the LICENSOR'S original cost for duplication.

10. Additional Revenue

In the event that the LICENSOR wishes to generate additional revenues from the "raw footage" through any transaction not specified in this Agreement, the LICENSOR shall notify the COUNTY. The COUNTY and LICENSOR shall exercise good faith and best efforts to attempt to negotiate a mutually acceptable royalty. If such efforts are not successful, all the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall govern the parties.

11. Liability

Neither party hereto shall be liable for any damages proximately resulting from the negligent or wrongful acts or omissions of the other party's employees or agents in the performance of this Agreement; and each party shall indemnify, defend and save harmless the other party from any such damage or liability.

12. Force Majeure

The LICENSOR shall not be in default by reason of any failure in performance of this Agreement in accordance with its terms if such failure arises out of causes beyond the control and without the fault

or negligence of the LICENSOR. Such causes may include, but are not restricted to, acts of God or of a public enemy, acts of the government in its sovereign capacity, strikes, freight embargoes; but in every case the failure to perform must be beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the LICENSOR.

13. <u>Termination</u>

This Agreement may be terminated at any time by either party upon giving at least 30 days notice to the other party of the intention to so terminate this Agreement, except that COUNTY may immediately terminate this Agreement upon any default on the part of the LICENSOR of any of the provisions of this Agreement.

14. Discrimination

The LICENSOR certifies and agrees that all persons employed by such firm, its affiliates, subsidiaries, or holding companies are and will be treated equally by the firm without regard to or because of race, religion, ancestry, national origin, or sex in compliance with all anti-discrimination laws of the United State of America and the State of California. The LICENSOR further agrees to promptly take any measure necessary to carry out the provision of this paragraph. The Agreements of the LICENSOR contained in this paragraph are given in consideration of the Agreements of the County of Los Angeles contained herein. The United States of America, the State of California, and the County of Los Angeles shall have the right to seek judicial enforcement of the provisions contained in this paragraph.

15. Assurance of Compliance with Civil Rights Laws

The LICENSOR hereby assures that it will comply with Subchapter VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 43 USC, Sections 2000e through

2000e (17), to the end that no person shall, on grounds of race, creed, color, sex or national origin be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefit of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under this Agreement or under any project, program, or activity supported by this Agreement.

16. Independent Contractor

Both parties hereto in the performance of this Agreement will be acting in an independent capacity and not as agents, employees, partners, joint ventures, or associates of one another.

17. Assignment or Subcontracting

No performance or right under this Agreement or any portion thereof may be assigned or subcontracted by the LICENSOR without the express written consent of the County of Los Angeles and any attempt by the LICENSOR to assign or subcontract any performance of the terms of this Agreement or right under this Agreement without the express written consent of the County of Los Angeles shall be null and void and shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.

LICENSOR'S request to the COUNTY for approval to assign or to enter into a subcontract shall include:

- A description of the services to be assigned or to be provided by the subcontract; and
- 2. Identification of the proposed subcontractor and a detailed description of the subcontractor selection process.

Subcontracts shall be made in the name of the LICENSOR and shall not bind or purport to bind the COUNTY. The making of subcontracts hereunder shall not relieve the LICENSOR of any requirement under this Agreement, including, but not limited to, the

duty to properly supervise and coordinate the work of subcontractors.

18. County Lobbyist Ordinance

LICENSOR and each County lobbyist or County lobbying firm as defined in Los Angeles County Code Section 2.160.010, retained by LICENSOR, shall fully comply with County Lobbyist Ordinance, Los Angeles County Code Chapter 2.160. Failure on the part of LICENSOR or any County lobbyist or County lobbying firm retained by LICENSOR to fully comply with the County Lobbyist Ordinance shall constitute a material breach of this Agreement upon which COUNTY may immediately terminate or suspend this Agreement.

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IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized officers as of the date set forth above.
