This is the electronic final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), dated and received by this office on April 30, 2021. You are seeking a copy of pages from the Senior Watch Officer (SWO) Log for the National Operations Center, DHS Office of Operations Coordination and Planning, related to the Charlottesville Unite the Right rally and counterprotests, August 11-12, 2017 and for three days before and three days afterward..

A search of DHS Office of Operations Coordination and Planning (OPS) for documents responsive to your request produced a total of two pages. Of those pages, I have determined that portions of the pages are partially releasable pursuant to Title 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(E), FOIA Exemption b7(E).

Enclosed are two pages with certain information withheld as described below:

**Exemption 7(E)** protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law. I determined that disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law. Additionally, the techniques and procedures at issue are not well known to the public.

You have a right to appeal the above withholding determination. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter, to: Privacy Office, Attn: FOIA Appeals, U.S. Department of Homeland Security, 2707 Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, SE, Mail Stop 0655, Washington, D.C. 20528-0655, following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.5(e)(2). Your envelope and letter should be marked "FOIA Appeal." Copies of the FOIA and DHS FOIA regulations are available at www.dhs.gov/foia.

Provisions of FOIA allow DHS to charge for processing fees, up to \$25, unless you seek a waiver of fees. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$25 minimum, there is no charge.
