This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) dated December 28, 2020, and received in our office on December 29, 2020. Your request was for:

A copy of documents discussing review of the NASA Langley CRGIS history page located here:

https://crgis.ndc.nasa.gov/historic/Langley_Research_Center

Including the reasons for the review, the scope of the review, and the schedule for the review.

The NASA's Langley Research Center conducted a search within the emails of those responsible for the CRGIS website utilizing the information above. That search identified 3 records consisting of 27 pages in response to your request. We have reviewed these records under the FOIA to determine whether they may be accessed under the FOIA's provisions.

Based on that review, this office is providing the following:

23 Pages are being released in part (RIP);
4 pages are being released in full (RIF).

NASA withheld the records pursuant to the following FOIA exemptions:

Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) Deliberative Process Privilege

FOIA Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5), protects “inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency.” Courts have interpreted Exemption 5 to incorporate three privileges: the attorney work-product privilege, the attorney-client privilege and the deliberative process privilege. NASA is invoking the deliberative process privilege, for the withheld records.

The deliberative process privilege is intended to protect the decision-making process of government agencies and to encourage frank discussion of legal and policy issues. The scope of the privilege covers documents reflecting advisory opinions, recommendations, and deliberations comprising part of a process by which government decisions and policies are formulated. To qualify for the deliberative process privilege, a document must be both "pre-decisional" and "deliberative." Documents are pre-decisional when they precede an agency decision and are prepared in order to assist an agency in arriving at its decision. Documents are deliberative when they comprise part of the process by which government decisions are made. The information NASA withheld under this exemption consisted of information that contained analysis and recommendations and/or opinions expressed by employees. NASA has considered the foreseeable harm that would result from the release of this information and determined that its release would hinder the decision-making process, create a chilling effect on internal deliberations, lead to uninformed decision-making, and public confusion.

Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) Personal Privacy

Exemption 6 “. . . allows the withholding of personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” NASA is invoking Exemption 6 to protect cell phone numbers. Additionally, there is no stated public interest in the disclosure of this information in the original FOIA request.

Exemption 7(E), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(E)

Exemption 7(E) protects all law enforcement information that “would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigation or prosecution, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecution if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.” *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(E). NASA is invoking Exemption 7(E) to protect IT Security techniques and procedures related to a website security issue. NASA has determined that releasing this information could compromise NASA’s IT critical infrastructure.

You have the right under 14 CFR §1206.700 to appeal this initial determination within 90 days from the date of this letter. Your appeal must be in writing and should be addressed to:

Your appeal should be marked "Appeal under the Freedom of Information Act" both on the envelope and the face of the letter. A copy of your initial request must be enclosed along with a copy of the adverse determination and any other correspondence with the FOIA office. In order to expedite the appellate process and ensure full consideration of your appeal, your appeal should contain a brief statement of the reasons you believe this initial decision to be in error.

Debbie and I spoke to Rob Wyman and Peter Mount this morning regarding the cultural resources website. The conversation explored two topics in detail, current temporary suspension of site (immediate concern) and future ownership.

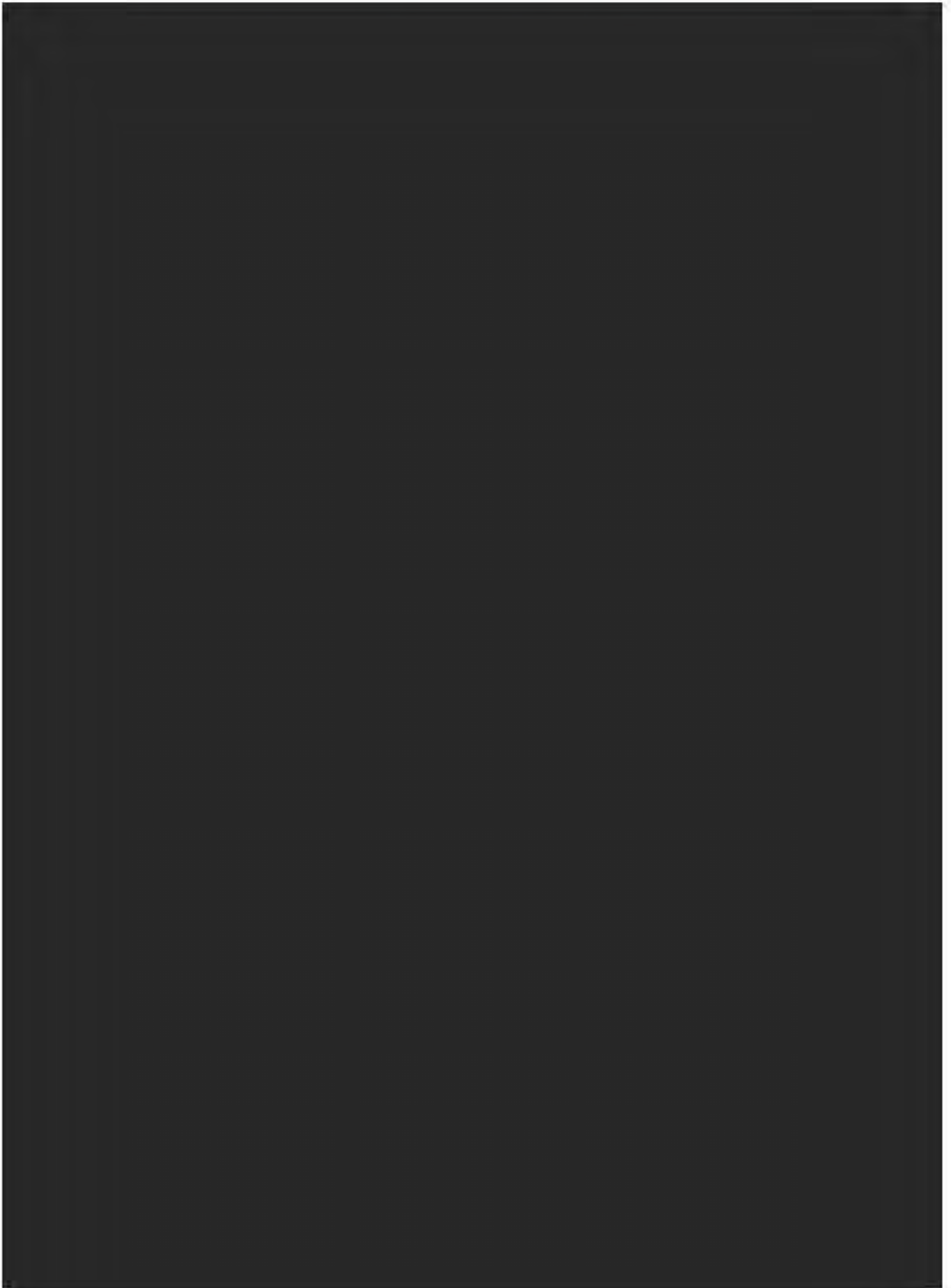
