This is in response to your October 14, 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, seeking access to records maintained by the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA). The TIGTA Disclosure Branch received your request via mail on October 19, 2021. Specifically, your request states:

TIGTA OPERATIONS MANUAL, Exhibit (500)80-1 TIGTA CONTENT PROVIDER LIST.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

The Office of Information Technology located the requested Exhibit (500) 80-1 TIGTA Content Provider List, and advised this office the contents of the Exhibit is obsolete. We are releasing Exhibit (500) 80-1 (four pages) in part and a copy is enclosed. We are asserting FOIA subsections (b)(6) and (b)(7)(E) as the justification for withholding.

FOIA subsection (b)(6) permits the withholding of records and information about individuals when disclosure of the information could result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The withheld information consists of identifying information compiled with regard to individuals other than you. Releasing the withheld information would not shed any light into the Agency's performance of its official functions, but instead could result in an invasion into the personal privacy of the individuals whose names and personal information have been withheld. As a result, the privacy interests of the third parties outweigh the public's interest in having the information released.

FOIA subsection (b)(7)(E) permits an agency to withhold “records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes ... [that] would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.” The information withheld pursuant to this exemption consists of information technology security guidelines, techniques, or tolerances the disclosure of which could lead to circumvention of the law. As a result, this information has been withheld in response to your request.

The cost incurred to process your FOIA request was less than \$25.00, the threshold set by Treasury’s FOIA regulation, so no fees were assessed.


