This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS). Your request was received on August 2, 2021 and sought access to: A copy of each listing of independent evaluations of the research and promotion commodity boards.

The AMS FOIA staff works with subject matter experts across the Agency to locate responsive documents. For this request, a search was conducted within the following AMS programs and offices which have oversight of the 22 research and promotion boards:

- Specialty Crops Program, specifically the Promotions and Economic Division, which has oversight of the Hass Avocado Board, U.S. Highbush Blueberry Council, Mushroom Council, National Mango Board, and the National Watermelon Promotion Board, American Pecan Promotion Board, Christmas Tree Promotion Board, National Honey Board, National Peanut Board, National Potato Promotion Board, Paper & Packaging Board, Popcorn Board, and the Softwood Lumber Board.
- Livestock and Poultry Program, specifically the Research and Promotion Division, which has oversight of the American Egg Board, American Lamb Board, Cattlemen's Beef Board, National Pork Board, United Soybean Board and the United Sorghum Checkoff Program.
- Cotton and Tobacco Program, which has oversight of the Cotton Board.
- Dairy Program, specifically the Promotion, Research, and Planning Division, which has oversight of the Fluid Milk Processors Promotion Program and the National Dairy Promotion & Research Board (Dairy Checkoff Program).

AMS' search began on August 4, 2021. As explained further below, your request is granted in full.

Each research and promotion board are required to have an independent evaluation of the effectiveness of the generic commodity promotion programs and other programs conducted by the board at least every 5 years unless otherwise provided by law.
