Re: Final Response to Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Appeal 2021-DA-00017-A

This is the final response to your FOIA appeal ("Appeal") to the U.S. Department of Agriculture ("USDA"), Office of Information Affairs ("OIA"). You appealed the OIA's final response to your September 30, 2019, FOIA request assigned tracking number 2020-DA-00001-F ("Request").

The Request sought:

[A] copy of all correspondence, memos, reports, emails, etc. (also including internal memoranda) regarding USDA Firm Fixed Price Contract 2314419C0002 awarded to Ernst & Young for USDA Site Solicitation Consulting Services, running 10/22/2018 through 10/23/2019. The solicitation ID was 12314219Q0006...

- ...the Statement of Work and any modifications to the contract.
- ...a copy of any Determinations and Findings or Justification and Approvals.
- ... a copy of all interchange such as emails, memos to the file, correspondence, or communications with the Contractor (to or from) the contractor.
- ...a copy of any reports or interim reports or updates produced by the Contractor.

On September 25, 2020, the OIA issued its final determination. You were advised that the OIA had performed a search and identified three hundred and one (301) pages of responsive records. It was determined that certain information contained in the final response should be withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5), and 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) (FOIA Exemptions 4, 5, and 6).

Additionally, you were advised that two hundred thirty-two (232) pages of records were withheld in their entirety under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) (FOIA Exemption 5). As an initial matter, the OIA has determined that only two hundred (200) pages were withheld in full under FOIA Exemption 5 in its final response.

While the Appeal states that you are not appealing the portions of the response withheld under FOIA Exemptions 4 or 6, it does not specifically identify the pages or information that is the subject of the appeal. The Appeal simply asserts that "hundreds of pages of records were denied seemingly without any attempt to release segregable releasable portions." See Appeal at page 1.

Therefore, this Appeal focuses on the two hundred (200) pages withheld in full under FOIA Exemption 5.

After careful consideration of the Appeal in its entirety, the remedies sought on appeal are being granted in full. As explained below, withholding the records in full under Exemption 5 was improper and the information can be released in its entirety.

1. <u>Application of Exemption 5 – Deliberative Process Privilege</u>

FOIA Exemption 5 protects from disclosure those "inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency." The deliberative process and the attorney-client privileges are two of the frequently invoked privileges under Exemption 5.

To fall within FOIA's deliberative process privilege, the records must be both pre-decisional and deliberative. The records must precede the adoption of an agency policy and include the opinions, recommendations, or deliberations on a legal or policy matter.

Exemption 5 threshold has also been expanded to cover certain situations in which an agency receives documents from an outside party, referred to as the "Consultant Corollary" to Exemption 5. In these cases, courts have emphasized that the agencies sought this outside advice, and that in providing their expertise, the consultants effectively functioned as agency employees, providing the agencies with advice similar to what it might have received from an employee. See <u>Dep't of the Interior v. Klamath Water Users Protective Ass'n</u>, 532 U.S. 1, 11 (2001).

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has reiterated that agencies should assert FOIA exemption only in those cases where the agency reasonably foresees that disclosure would be harmful to an interest protected by that exemption. Additionally, agencies shall "take reasonable steps necessary to segregate and release nonexempt information." See <u>FOIA Improvement Act of 2016 (Public Law No. 114-185)</u>.

a. Application of Exemption 5 to the Responsive Records

In its final response, the OIA withheld in full contract deliverables related to a site selection services contract between USDA and Ernst & Young ("EY"). The information withheld in full under Exemption 5 consisted of weekly and monthly project status reports submitted as deliverables under the contract between USDA and EY.

Upon review, this information can be released in full. Disclosure would not cause foreseeable harm to the agency's decision-making process or have a chilling effect on internal discussions

regarding policy, nor would disclosure cause public confusion on the agency's actual position on the policy at issue. The materials contain factual statements of accomplishments, objectives, deliverables, upcoming activities, and criteria against which project decisions were made. The materials relate to a consulting services contract that was completed in 2019. Similarly, the initial agency proposal to relocate the Economic Research Service (ERS) and National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) was published in 2018 with the site location decision made in 2019. Therefore, the harm in releasing status updates for a completed project that was publicized and vetted through the agency's rigorous site selection process, is minimal.
