## EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

Loompanics Unlimited, 2026 North Cedar Street, Holt, Michigan, was last registered as an assumed name in Ingham County, Michigan, on July 22, 1979, by [redacted]. Loompanics was originally filed as an assumed name by [redacted] on January 17, 1974. When [redacted] registered the assumed name, he listed the purpose of the business as "books".

Post Office Box 264, Mason, Michigan, was [redacted] on December 4, 1973. At that time, [redacted] listed an address of [redacted]. The primary receiver of mail was listed as Loompanics Unlimited. As of August 2, 1979, the address for Loompanics Unlimited was changed to 2026 North Cedar Street, Holt, Michigan. Defense Systems, Incorporated, and Twentieth Century Manufacturing, Incorporated, are also listed as firms authorized to receive mail at Post Office Box 264, Mason, Michigan.

Loompanics Unlimited, Defense Systems, Incorporated, and Twentieth Century Manufacturing, Incorporated, are not registered as corporations with the Corporations and Securities Bureau, Michigan Department of Commerce, Lansing, Michigan.

On March 16, 1981, an Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation made contact with personnel of Loompanics Unlimited. All of the windows to the establishment were observed to be covered with paper and there was a small sign on the entrance which read as follows: Loompanics Unlimited; 2026 North Cedar Street; Mail Order Only; Not for the General Public. Inside the building two female employees were observed preparing books for mailing. A request was made for a catalog of books presently being sold by Loompanics Unlimited. Furnished were the Loompanics Unlimited 1980 Main Catalog, the 1980 Summer Supplement, and the New Year's Supplement.

On October [ ], 1976, in the United States District Court for the Western District of Michigan, Grand Rapids, Michigan, [ ] pled guilty to a charge of [ ]. [ ] was subsequently sentenced to ten days in jail, fined five hundred dollars, and placed on thirty months probation.

Investigation in that case had determined that [ ] using the alias [ ], was [ ] two businesses using the assumed names of [ ].

[ ] At this same time, there was a firm in New York City, New York, by the name of Tena Notions which was in the business of supplying fraudulent birth records and other documentation to individuals for the purpose of obtaining welfare benefits. Tena Notions would supply [ ] with the age, sex, and ethnic origin of a person requesting fraudulent documentation and [ ] would then search the obituary columns for the name of a deceased infant or individual who, if still living, would match that description. Once the name of the deceased person was obtained, [ ] would apply for a copy of that individual's birth record and forward it to Tena Notions.

Drugs, guns, tax evasions, armed robberies, serial killers and home-made bombs...

It sounds like the makings of a drug store detective novel. But instead this is real how-to material, all available in the Loompanics Unlimited mail-order catalog.

Loompanics, a Port Townsend book publisher and distributor, has a reputation for specializing in the unusual, the illegal, the clandestine and the down-right offensive. It's the kind of stuff that makes televangelists roar and politicians shudder.

But Loompanics Editor Steve O'Keefe sees another side to the business. He believes thought-provoking political essays and information geared toward personal empowerment and self-reliance is really the back-bone of Loompanics. It promotes what O'Keefe calls "practical anarchism." That, he said, is the notion that you don't need to overthrow the government when you can just ignore it.

### Mercenary manual

This subversive attitude, along with outrageous mail-order catalogs, gives Loompanics an underground quality. The book selection, true to its reputation, is unusual: "Serial Slaughter", "How To Start Your Own Country", "The Abolition of Work", "Making Crime Pay", "Successful Armed Robbery", "Vigilante Handbook", "Manual of the Mercenary Soldier", "Marijuana Grower's Guide", "Getting Started in the Illicit Drug Business", "The Construction and Operation of Clandestine Drug Laboratories" (by Jack B. While O'Keefe refuses any attempt to categorize Loompanics customers, he does believe many

Loompanics books appeal to the sense of humor and imagination of anyone who enjoys mocking the authority of an oppressive government.

"Circulating books on growing marijuana undermines authority and appeals to an element of Americans who think drug laws are tyrannical and stupid, for instance, he said.

"Our holiday supplement will feature several articles extolling the wonderful virtues of the hemp plant that we're forbidden by law to take advantage of," said Loompanics Publisher Michael Hoy, who shares O'Keefe's general contempt for authority.

With an 800-book selection,

including 150 exclusive how-to books, Loompanics has gained devoted customers from various walks of life and both sides of the law.

"We have a lot of prisoners on our list," Hoy said. "We have to tear out certain pages."

"We're giving people information so they can do things for themselves," O'Keefe said. "Some of it's not socially acceptable."

Socially acceptable or not, they get orders from the Central Intelligence Agency, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Justice Department, and the Detroit Police Department, which orders "Body Guarding" in volumes of 50.

O'Keefe beams as he remembers filling an order for several copies of a book requested by the C.F.A. It was entitled "Methods of Disguise." He is fascinated by the vague line separating fantasy from reality; a line obscured further by Loompanics material.

O'Keefe and Hoy enjoy books that shatter a reader's self-created vision of reality, leaving him or her to pick up the pieces.

## Severed head

Hoy is attracted to books that challenge his view of the world, knock him over the head with a new thought, or trip him up in some other fashion.

"Keeping A Severed Head Alive" is a good example of what Hoy looks for in a good manuscript.

"We look for some outrageous subject that is treated dead-pan, how to do it," Hoy said.

A market for the outrageous definitely exists. While new books start with printings of 1,000 copies or less, Loompanics still grossed more than \$1 million last year.

Hoy, formerly an accountant, published his first book in 1975 when he made 500 copies of an index to National Lampoon. He only sold about 65.

"I was trying to figure out some way to make a living without having a job," Hoy said. "I could see it was going to be years before I made money off my own publishing."

That's when Hoy decided to carry books from other publishers. Loompanics' first profitable books Hoy wrote himself, including "Exotic Weapons: An Access Book", and a book on obtaining mail order identification.

"Eventually the government passed laws prohibiting that kind of thing" which killed sales on his I.D. book, Hoy said.

Many of the other books can also be used for illegal purposes. The Loompanics all-time greatest seller, "The Complete Guide

to Lock Picking" (by Eddie the Wire), sold about 35,000 copies. Yet Hoy said many locksmiths and other people undoubtedly buy the book without any devious purposes in mind.

## Filling a void

Besides, he doesn't really care what people do with his books.

He's concerned with filling a void by offering books too unusual to be obtained anywhere else. The mail-order system, in which customers often use fake names, has its advantages as well; it offers customers anonymity.

Not everyone feels comfortable walking into a store and buying books like "Physical Interrogation Techniques", which caused a revolt among Loompanics employees and seven publishers refused to print.

"I didn't realize printers actually read the stuff they print," Hoy said. "It grossed out a lot of people. Somebody is probably having that stuff done to them in Central America somewhere right now."

Hoy views the book as an enlightening peek at the "dark side

of law enforcement and politics.

Amnesty International has bought several copies of the book, lending support to Hoy's argument the book could be a deterrent rather than a contributor to human rights abuses.

## Boring not allowed

Hoy has never turned down a manuscript because it was too offensive or dangerous. The only thing Hoy won't tolerate is boring material and material that's not factually correct.

Hoy said many people like himself are likely to read how-to books for pleasure, not necessarily intending to act on what they read.

"It's for anyone whose curious, loves books and likes to read strange stuff," Hoy said.

Sitting in his office, petting a large cat named Fang, his collection of exotic weapons suspended on the walls, loads of mail and other debris strewn around him, Hoy seems to be in his natural element.

Hoy, 46, moved to Port Townsend in 1982 from Lansing, Michigan. He describes himself as a libertarian and an anarchist with a small "l" and small "a".

Hoy, from an early age, has enjoyed reading Edgar Allen Poe, as well as westerns and espionage novels. He's an avid reader of anything that's interesting and entertaining.

Like a mischievous child or a clever flasher, he seems to derive pleasure from the outrage his books cause in conservative God-fearing people. He likes the outrage, the freedom and the profit he derives from his unique business. He also enjoys the freedom his business gives him; the freedom to set his own hours and wear what he wants, and the freedom to spend hours reading the piles of mail that flow in.

"I just love what I do," Hoy said. "It's definitely more fun than being an accountant."

It's also a more secret. Loompanics keeps its location secret; catalogues are available by sending \$5 to P.O. box 1197 in




