## EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information ( A ) could be reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, ( B ) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, ( C ) could be reasonably expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, ( D ) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, ( E ) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or ( F ) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

On October 17, 1957, [redacted] of the Liaison Section that the President was deeply concerned with the problem of calling a special session of Congress in the event of an emergency. [redacted] advised that his office has been given the duty of drawing up workable plans for notification to members of Congress if the emergency happens while Congress is not meeting. [redacted] said that Congress has taken a rather disinterested view in a relocation site for Congress and that as a result only the majority and minority leaders of both Houses know the actual location of the Congressional relocation site. [redacted] said that the President is seeking an answer to the question of how to notify these members if they are scattered throughout the country so that a quorum could be assembled to handle emergency business at the Congressional relocation site.

[redacted] suggested that the FBI is the most responsible agency of Government and most strategically located by field offices to aid in this problem. [redacted] asked that the Bureau consider the White House proposition that each field office of the FBI be furnished with a sealed envelope containing the location of the Congressional relocation site with instructions that this envelope be opened only in the event of a national emergency plus the Presidential proclamation for a special session of Congress. Each Congressman and Senator would be told to get in touch with the nearest FBI field office and identify himself and that the FBI would tell him at that time the location of the emergency Congressional relocation site. According to [redacted] the FBI would have no responsibility in locating members of Congress. He said that he hoped this added duty would not interfere with the over-all important activities that the Bureau will be engaged in at the outbreak of an emergency.

[redacted] advised that this plan is not final but is one of several being considered at this time for the handling of the problem. [redacted] pointed out to [redacted] that tremendous responsibilities are placed on the Bureau at the outbreak of hostilities and that these responsibilities must be met by the Bureau in order to insure the internal security of the United States; that every ounce of energy from

every FBI Agent is needed during a critical period. [redacted] told [redacted] that he would take this matter up at the Bureau and that an answer would be forthcoming in the near future.

On the evening of October 18, [redacted] telephoned [redacted] and made reference to his inquiry and stated that the committee at the White House handling this matter was going to get together on Wednesday, October 23, and if possible he would appreciate an answer by that time.

OBSERVATION:

It is logical to assume that the Presidential proclamation calling a special session of Congress will immediately follow the beginning of hostilities. At that strategic point the Bureau will be using every agent to fulfill its obligations in rounding up enemy aliens and delegates of enemy countries plus handling our other assigned duties, such as matters dealing with espionage, sabotage and internal security.

It is possible that some member of Congress might come to an FBI office after the beginning of an emergency period and prior to the Presidential proclamation calling for a special session of Congress. If the member of Congress should demand the identity of the Congressional relocation site and the Bureau not furnish it to him, the Bureau would be put in a bad light.

RECOMMENDATION:

If you approve, Liaison will advise [redacted] at the White House, after considering this problem the Bureau feels that this added duty imposed on the Bureau at this critical period would hamper our already assigned duties; therefore, the Bureau feels that we should not take on this added duty, as it could also prove embarrassing to the Bureau, White House and members of Congress to make it a requirement for members of Congress to come to the FBI before the location of their relocation site could be disclosed. This implies that the White House does not sufficiently trust the rank and file of the Congress to tell them now of the site for convening the Congress in case of emergency. We will point these factors out to [redacted] so that the matter may be further considered by the White House.

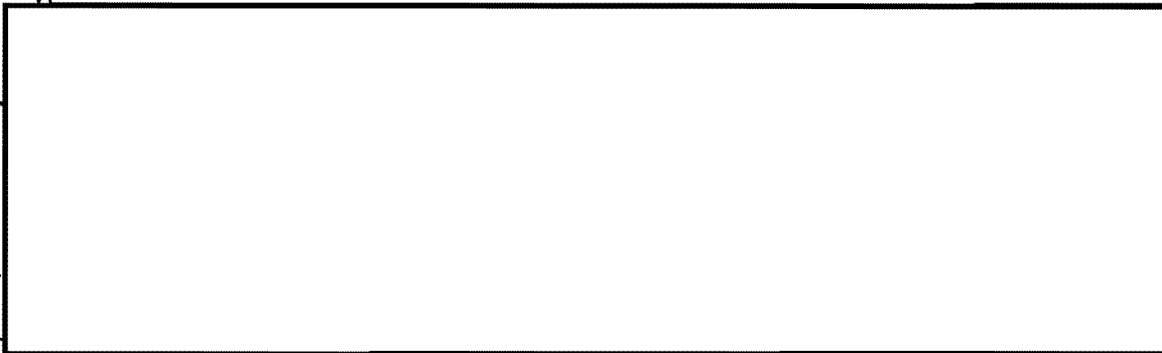

This Bureau has been advised by the Office of Civil and Defense Mobilization that the following plan for advising Members of Congress of the actual location of their relocation site has been approved by Congressional leaders and carries Presidential sanction. This plan would be utilized by the President to convene Congress at the "classified" Congressional relocation site when Congress is not meeting, either because not in session or, if in session, because of recess or because the session has been disrupted by an armed attack or other disaster.

Referral/Consult



Under present concepts, the Federal Bureau of Investigation is prepared, in event of emergency, to relocate all its field offices and Bureau Headquarters. At such time as the relocation is accomplished, the various relocation sites will no longer be classified and a public announcement concerning their location will be made by every available means.

The plan for notification of the Members of Congress as outlined above will be made a part of the defense plan of each Federal Bureau of Investigation office.
