This is the final response to your April 16, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of the Special Inspector General for Afghanistan Reconstruction (SIGAR) for "an electronic copy of the SIGAR FOIA Case Log from the beginning of SIGAR to the present, an electronic copy of SIGAR Audit 10-5, and an electronic list of SIGAR Investigations closed since the beginning of SIGAR, taken from the SIGAR electronic database of investigations." Your request was received in this office on April 26, 2011.

We granted your request under the FOIA, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. Our search has revealed four pages responsive to your requests. We cannot fulfill your request for Audit 10-5, as the audit did not run to completion and, accordingly, SIGAR did not generate an audit report. After an initial review of responsive documents, I determined that portions of them are exempt from disclosure under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6). We are releasing a total of four pages, two pages are being released in part, and two pages are being released in their entirety.

Exemption 6 allows the withholding of information prohibited from disclosure about individuals in "personnel and medical files and similar files" when the disclosure of such information "would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."

Under the FOIA's administrative appeal provision, a requester has the right to administratively appeal any adverse determination an agency makes on his or her FOIA request. If you are not satisfied with this determination, you may appeal to the appellate authority within 60 days from the date of this letter. Your appeal should include a copy of your original request and this response, as well as a discussion of the reasons supporting your appeal. The envelope should be plainly marked to indicate that it contains a Freedom of Information Act appeal. If you decide to appeal, please send your appeal to:
