This responds to your January 9, 2023, request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, for a list of the Office of Inspector General's investigations that were closed in calendar years 2021 and 2022. Please note that we maintain our investigative activity reports on a fiscal year basis, which begins each year on October 1 and ends on September 30 the following year.

I conducted a search and located two pages responsive to your request. I withheld names and other identifying information of investigation subjects whose grade levels were below CU-15 and investigation subjects when our investigation did not sustain the allegations, pursuant to Exemptions (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of FOIA, which protect personal privacy interests.

If you are not satisfied with my action on this request, you may file an administrative appeal in writing within 90 days of the date of this letter. If you file an appeal, please note "FOIA APPEAL" in the letter and on the envelope (or in the subject line of email to <u>foia@ncua.gov</u>) and address it to: National Credit Union Administration, Office of General Counsel-FOIA APPEAL, 1775 Duke Street, Alexandria, VA 22314-3428. A copy of your initial request and a copy of this letter should accompany your appeal letter.
