This letter is a final response to your 24 September 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a copy of the cover page and/or title page only for the CIA Congressional Budget Justification for each fiscal year FY1970 through FY1985. We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA (5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 3141, as amended).

We completed a thorough search for records responsive to your request and located the enclosed fifteen documents. Five documents can be released in their entirety and 10 documents can be released in segregable form with deletions made on the basis of FOIA exemption (b)(3). Exemption (b)(3) pertains to information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant statutes are Section 6 of the Central Intelligence Agency Act of 1949, as amended, and Section 102A(i)(l) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended.

As the CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 90 days from the date of this letter. Please explain the basis for your appeal.


