This is in response to the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. A copy of your request is attached for review.

In response to your request, staff located 24 pages of responsive records, which were forwarded to this office for a release determination. After careful review, we determined 22 pages are appropriate for release in full and 2 pages are appropriate for release in part. Copies of released records are attached. Please note, the NIC website (Advisory Board Public Hearings & Outcomes | National Institute of Corrections (nicic.gov)) has been updated since the submission of your request.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, records were redacted under the following exemptions: (b)(6), Permits withholding of records and information about individuals when disclosure would be a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. (b)(7)(C), Permits withholding of records when an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy could reasonably be expected. BOP considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing responsive records and applying FOIA exemptions.
