Since this failure to adopt the regulation is so critical to LSC's position, I thought it would be useful to investigate the regulatory process which resulted in the "non-adoption" (My thinking was that maybe the failure to adopt the proposed change was superfluous given the plain language of the regulation). Since this failure to adopt the regulation is so critical to LSC's position, I thought it useful to investigate the regulatory process which resulted in the "non-adoption". (My thinking was that maybe the failure to adopt the proposed change was that it was superfluous given the plain language of the regulation). I requested copies of the comments and when that met with what seemed to be a stone wall, I then requested copies of the minutes of the Board meeting where the regulation was discussed. In the best of all possible worlds, I would like copies of the comments as well as the minutes of the Board or committee meeting where the decision was made not to adopt the proposed reg. It is with our sincerest apologies that we submit for your consideration the delayed response of the Legal Services Corporation (“LSC” or “Corporation”) to your January 25, 2011, request for information relating to the Corporation’s implementation of the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”). On March 15, 2012, upon learning of your Committee’s report, *“Report Card on Federal Government’s Efforts to Track and Manage FOIA Requests,”* we immediately launched an internal inquiry to determine what had happened with your letter of January 25, 2011.

We checked mail logs and the email of individuals who might have received your request. What we were able to determine was that the request was transmitted to LSC on January 27, 2011, by email addressed to our FOIA Officer. Regrettably, our FOIA Officer overlooked it and it was not until March 15, 2012, during our internal inquiry, that it was found and opened. It was in an email transmission from Ms. Tegan Millspaw and, like the email, the request letter it transmitted was addressed to our FOIA Officer.

Please be assured that this was an innocent – albeit woefully negligent and inexcusable – oversight and that otherwise LSC would have promptly responded to it. We take very seriously any request from a Committee or Member of Congress and most certainly meant no disrespect. LSC also has a strong commitment to FOIA, starting from the very top. LSC President James Sandman has evidenced his own commitment by insisting that the Corporation conduct its business in a transparent manner and issuing a FOIA policy statement within weeks of his arrival at LSC in 2011. At his request, President Sandman receives a FOIA update report every week. He carefully reviews each one and often has follow-up questions and instructions. Also, earlier this month he reissued his FOIA policy statement to all staff, as a reminder to those who had previously received it and to ensure that all new staff member are familiar with it.

We have gone through our records and put together the information requested in your letter of January 25, 2011. For your convenience, a log setting out that information is enclosed in both the requested format and as a pdf document. It is provided both as an Excel spreadsheet and as a pdf document because some of the text in the longer entries on the Excel spreadsheet is visible only when the cursor is positioned over the individual cell and does not shown when the Excel version of the log is printed. However, the pdf version displays all of each entry in its entirety when printed.

I note, however, that the Corporation's records retention policy provides for the disposal of FOIA responses two years after closure of the request. Data related to a FOIA response are removed from the database upon disposal of the related file. Therefore, the Corporation's database does not contain information for FOIA requests closed prior to January 15, 2009. It does, however, contain the information for the last 3 years and 2 months.

The following responses and explanations are offered with regard to item nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 of your request:

**Item No. 2**

On each log provided in response to Request No. 1, identify each FOIA request to your agency that was submitted more than 45 days prior to the date of this letter and to which your agency has not yet issued a complete and final response.

**Response to No. 2** An asterisk appears beside the tracking numbers of the FOIA requests received more than 45 days before January 25, 2011, the date of your letter, and for which LSC had not issued a complete and final response as of that date. We have also provided information on FOIA requests received from that time to the date of this letter.

**Request No. 3**

For each FOIA request identified in response to Request No. 2, provide all communication between your agency and the requestor.

**Response to No. 3**

Copies of the communications between the Corporation and the individual FOIA requesters are enclosed pursuant to your request.

**Request No. 4**

Identify any federal judicial action in which your agency, within the five years preceding the date of this letter, has been ordered by the court to pay any attorneys' fees or other litigation costs incurred by a FOIA requestor under 5 U.S.C. § 55(a)(4)(E) or under any similar law or regulation.

**Response to No. 4**

The Corporation has not been ordered by any court to pay attorneys' fees or other litigation costs incurred by a FOIA requester under 5 U.S.C. § 55(a)(4)(E) or under any similar law or regulation within the five years preceding January 25, 2011, or between that date and the date of this letter.

**Request No. 5**

For each federal action identified in response to Request No. 4, provide a copy of the court order requiring your agency to pay attorney fees or other litigation costs.


