This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of 6 March 2010 for "a copy of the Agency log or listing of Mandatory Declassification Review Requests at the National Security Agency." A copy of your request is enclosed. Your request has been processed under the FOIA and the documents you requested are enclosed. Certain information, however, has been deleted from the enclosures.

The names of NSA/CSS employees have been deleted from the enclosures. The appeal shall reference the initial denial of access and shall contain, in sufficient detail and particularity, the grounds upon which the requester believes release of the information is required. The NSA/CSS Appeal Authority will endeavor to respond to the appeal within 20 working days after receipt, absent any unusual circumstances.

Please be advised that information pertaining to referrals and/or consultations from other government agencies was determined to be not responsive to the subject of your request and has been removed from the enclosures and marked "Non-Responsive."
