This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) received on 12 September 2017, requesting copies of the title pages and table of contents for Volume 1 and 2 of the Fundamental Elements of the Counterintelligence (CI) Discipline and the National CI Training Standards Level 1.

This request was processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. A thorough search was conducted and three (3) responsive records were located. During the review process, we considered the foreseeable harm standard and determined that certain information must be withheld pursuant to the following FOIA exemptions:

- (b)(3), which applies to information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant statute includes the National Security Act of 1947, as amended, specifically:
 - Section 102A(h)(1) (codified at 50 U.S.C. § 3024(h)(1)), which mandates the protection of intelligence sources and methods from unauthorized disclosure.

If you are not satisfied with this response, a number of options are available.
