This is in response to your May 21, 2013, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) appeal letter in which you are appealing the FOIA exemption b5 withholding of DCAA documents projecting the possible impact of sequestration on agency functions and operations. Your original Freedom of Information Act request was dated April 27, 2013, (DCAA FOIA Case Number I-13-050-H).

Based upon a new review of responsive records originally withheld by DCAA, it has been determined that these documents projecting the possible impact of sequestration on DCAA functions and operations may now be released to you. Therefore, I carefully reviewed the documents responsive to your request and determined that eleven documents, totaling sixty-six pages, on the enclosed compact disc may be released to you with redactions. The redactions are in accordance with the FOIA under the following exemption: (b)(5), information is predecisional inter/intra agency data that is part of a decision-making process containing opinions and recommendations.

For your information, one document totaling twenty-one pages, has been determined not to be responsive to your original request. The document discussed DCAA's mission and activities prior to the formulation of sequestration.

This determination is the final decision of this Agency on your appeal. If you disagree with this decision, you may seek judicial review in the United States District Courts in the district where you are located, where the requested information is located, or in the U.S. District Court of the District of Columbia.

Background DCAA has been asked to provide the potential impact on DCAA's operations of a 20 percent reduction to the Agency's fiscal year 2014 budget. In a word, the impact would be devastating on our workforce and mission. A 20 percent cut equates to about \$122.4 million in direct funding in fiscal year 2014 plus an associated \$13.2 million reduction in reimbursable earnings. DCAA would be forced to take that cut almost exclusively in personnel costs. A funding cut of this magnitude would result in a loss of over 1,200 workyears from the fiscal year 2014 President's Budget.

Impact on Staffing First, due to the hiring freeze implemented in 2013, at the end of fiscal year 2013 the Agency will already be at a much lower staffing level than approved in the budget for fiscal year 2014. The 2013 hiring freeze results in a loss of almost 600 workyears compared to the President's Budget. (b) (5)

DCAA would not be able to achieve the additional reductions in personnel needed to execute the 20 percent reduction through attrition alone. Based on historical attrition rates, DCAA would only be able to reduce 300 to 350 positions through attrition resulting in only a 175 workyear reduction in fiscal year 2014. To accommodate a 20 percent budget cut, the Agency would have to resort to a combination of harsh staffing reduction measures. (b) (5)

Additional resources have been allocated to DCAA over the last several years as part of the Department's focus on creating a more robust acquisition workforce to support Better Buying Power and to add audit capacity which has been recognized across the Department as critical. Combining a fiscal year 2013 hiring freeze and a 20 percent reduction in fiscal year 2014 will cause the DCAA to reduce in two years the programmed staff growth which we have achieved over the last four years.

<u>Impact on Mission</u> To absorb a staffing cut of more than 1,200 workyears, DCAA would have to reduce audit effort throughout its audit portfolio. A reduction of this level would have a damaging impact on DCAA's ability to perform its mission and a commensurate reduction in savings to the taxpayer and warfighter.

DCAA's audit requirements have always outpaced its resources. The Agency's annual audits requirements exceed 10,000 workyears. At its peak in 1990 DCAA had a total staff of almost 6,900. Between 1999 and 2008 DCAA staff averaged less than 4,000. An independent Army study from July 2010, recommended DCAA needed a workforce of 6,250.

In order to address the imbalance between requirements and resources, the Agency has implemented a risk-based approach to planning and performing audits. This strategy focuses on audit effort with the highest payback to the taxpayer and warfighter. For example, the Department has implemented revised procedures to allow for sampling of low-risk incurred cost

proposals. In another illustration, the Department raised the thresholds for requesting forward pricing proposal audits. These changes have allowed hundreds of workyears to be redirected to higher risk work.

Over the last 3 years the Agency has worked hard to balance audit requirements with resources and this approach has met with much success. DCAA's net savings in 2012 was \$4.2 billion, the highest in the Agency's history. This figure is a continuation of a three-year trend of increased savings for the taxpayer. Specifically, between 2002 and 2009, DCAA averaged \$2.5 billion in annual net savings. Over the last three years, DCAA's net savings averaged \$3.5 billion, a 40 percent increase.

However, this risk-based approach means the Agency has already divested itself of almost all of its low-risk work. Therefore, a 20 percent reduction to the Agency's budget will severely harm the ability of the Agency to carry out high risk audits. This reduction will also impact the Agency's ability to support the Department's Better Buying Power initiatives of affordable programs and controlling costs.

A 20 percent reduction in the Agency's budget would force large reductions in effort related to key mission areas as described below:





• Other Audit Effort – The 20 percent cut in the Agency's budget would result in reduction or elimination of effort in the following audit areas:



<u>Impact on Net Savings</u> – In fiscal year 2012, DCAA saved \$4.2 billion for the Department (\$6.70 for every dollar invested). Importantly, this return on taxpayer investment represents real savings that enable the Department to do more—get more equipment, services, and supplies—with fewer dollars. Given the direct relationship to DCAA's audit mission and its impact on both cost avoidance and checks written by contractors to return funds to the US treasury, DCAA is one of the top oversight organizations in providing realized versus potential savings to the taxpayer and warfighter.
